All race fees must be received before the draw.

Entries close at 5pm on Sunday 1st May. Draw to take place on Monday 2nd May.

All senior, junior, and masters categories offered*

In addition, there will be a masters beginners category for masters rowers new to competition in 4+ and 4x

*Subject to sufficient demand. The competition will comply with the British Rowing Rules of Racing.

A minimum of three entries is required to guarantee the running of an event.

Event categories will be set based on entries received in each boat class according to the PRI system.

If there are fewer than three entries, crews may be moved up a band or handicapped in the case of masters.

Entries for masters beginner events should be entered in BROE as MasA beginner;

depending on entries received the organisers may band according to BR masters age categories.

Please indicate on your entry form a second choice of boat class in case there are insufficient entries for your first choice.

Doubling up is at an entrants own risk. Please make doubling up very clear when submitting entries.

All boats must be provided by competitors and clubs are responsible for the safety of their members and equipment.

Neither MAABC nor Borne @ Chiswick Bridge Regatta will accept liability.
